

Pre-Booking Questions from a Bride & Groom/Answers from me

- 1.) What type of equipment will you bring with you? **Standard equipment 2 speakers, sub, powered mixer, DJ mixer, computer and some lights. It works great**
- 2.) How many breaks do you typically take during the evening? We plan on giving you a dinner. **No breaks at all. That's the best reason to hire a DJ. Dinner's great, I can just eat at my DJ table**
- 3.) What type of music do you typically play during dinner time. **You can choose dinner music too but mostly I play a mix of Sinatra, Jack Johnson, Harry Conick Jr, Ray Lamontagne, Michael Buble, James Taylor, Van Morrison, Adele etc.**
- 4.) How many songs can we include that aren't on your list? **As many as you want, just make sure to do a 5/10 system as described in the packet**
- 5.) When we looked at the list that you sent us, we really don't want most common wedding music- will you be flexible with our music selections? **That is just a sample list. I have over 10,000 songs. I'll play whatever you want.**
- 6.) If the music list runs out, what is your typical back up music? **I read the crowd and play a mix and requests**

Questions from a prospective client with answers from a bride, Lisa Bruinooge

- 1) Was he professional? Timely? Organized? **Yes- professional and timely- DJ Dave will provide you with a package that will help organize all of the final details when it comes closer to the wedding (such as picking out a cake cutting song, first dance, parent dance, last dance, etc- and if you want to do any wedding traditions like tossing the flowers, etc- which we didn't do)**
- 2) Did he play a wide range of music? **YES- I provided him a list of artists that I loved and particular songs that I wanted played- There was a nice range of music to entertain the young and the old. I like the top 40, my husband likes more alternative music- we also had some oldies thrown in there with some country per my request. I don't think there was one song that people didn't dance to- even during dinner- many couples were slow dancing before the real dance music started.**
- 3) Did the guests dance during his sets?- **They certainly did! there were several performances as well- I should lend you my wedding CD- it's got some great footage- our wedding was incredible and I'm not just saying that b/c it was my wedding. We had some people do dance performances, singing performances, etc...it was great!**
- 4) What was the best aspect of his performance? **Everything was great- Just seeing everyone dancing from young to old was amazing. He was very professional and he was very flexible- he went with what the crowd wanted, and would consult me if the time was coming close to an end to see what songs i would prefer to hear.**
- 5) What was the worst aspect of his performance? **I don't know if I could say there was a worst aspect- he was reasonably priced (because he had to travel to NH, I had to pay for his hotel, but that was fine b/c his rates were still lower than local DJs). He's a one man show, but he's great.**
- 6) Would you hire him again for your wedding? **Definitely! I have recommended him to my friends who have also used him.**
- 7) What was your wedding size, location, etc.? **Size was around 150 guests, location was at the Bedford Village Inn (Bedford NH).**
